'And I pray...that you may have power, together with all the Saints to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ' Eph. 3 v.18

'that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God' Eph.3 v.19

'Therefore put on the full armour of God so that when the evil day comes, you may be able to stand your ground' Eph. 6 v.13

'so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ' Phil 1 v.10
