- 2. Why do you think the Bible talks so much about money and giving?
- 3. On a large sheet of paper list as many reasons why you think the Bible teaches that we should give.
- 4. Read 1 Corinthians 16 vs 1-4

Background - In the early years of the Church there was a severe famine in Jerusalem. Paul decided it would be a good idea if each church outside the famine area, collected money so that when he next called by, he could take the money to Jerusalem to buy food.

Prayer.

Light a candle and think through your own giving to God - your time, your skills and your money. You might want to read the following verses at intervals.

You know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ; rich as he was, he made himself poor for your sake, in order to make you rich by means of his poverty. (2 Cor. 8 v. 9)

If you are eager to give, God will accept your gift on the basis of what you have to give, not on what you don't have. (2 Cor. 8 v.12)

Remember that the person who plants few seeds will have a small crop; the one who plants many seeds will have a large crop. (2 Cor 9 v.6)

You should each give, then, as you have decided, not with regret or out of a sense of duty; for God loves the one who gives gladly._(2 Cor 9 v.7)
